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| 1 | Gavi di Gavi La Meirana 2017
Piedmont, Italy | £20.00 |
| | Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is particularly characterful Gavi. | |
| 2 | Bramito del Cervo (Chardonnay) 2017 | £20.00 |
| | The baby brother of the iconic Cervaro della Sala is an exceptional wine in its own right, with a tautly structured palate and aromas of apples, citrus and toast. | |
| 3 | Bianco Secco, Quintarelli Giuseppe 2016 Veneto | £36.00 |
| | Intense floral nose with clear hints of wisteria flowers, together with bananas and pears. Strikingly fresh on the palate, well-balanced with good weight and structure. Dry and refreshing on the finish. | |
| 4 | Chardonnay Contea di Sclafani 2016
Contea di Sclafani DOC, Italy | £48.50 |
| | Complex bouquet of banana, pineapple, citrus, candied fruit, vanilla, cinnamon and white chocolate. The palate is very rich and intense with a serious mineral seam. | |
| 5 | Torcicoda (Primitivo) 2016
Salento IGT, Italy | £22.50 |
| | Typical varietal aromas: rich, ripe red fruits alongside a light element of prune and some spice from the wood. Soft, round and full-bodied on the palate, with a depth and wild complexity that sets it apart. | |
| 6 | Il Bruciato (Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot/Syrah) 2015 | £28.50 |
| | Fragrant fruity aromas, particularly plum, followed by delicate mint and green tea notes. On the palate it is full-bodied and smooth with a long finish. | |
| 7 | Rosso del Conte Contea di Sclafani (Nero d'Avola) 2013 | £65.50 |
| | An extremely complex, intense bouquet of wild berries, walnuts, cinnamon and tobacco leads to a richly concentrated, mouthfilling palate that combines thrilling old-vine depth with a certain deftness and elegance. | |
| 8 | Vinsanto del Chianti Classico 2012
Tuscany, Italy
Trebiano, small percentage of Malvasia | £37.50 |
| | This historic dessert wine shows generous, complex aromas with hints of honey and dried fruit. A well-structured, pleasantly sweet and persistent flavour. | |
